

Remove test tube from Octa-Slide 2 Viewer.

Add one DPD #3R Tablet [6905A] to sample from Step 6.

8.

Cap and mix until tablet disintegrates



9.

Insert test tube into Octa-Slide 2 Viewer.



10.

Hold the Viewer so that non-direct light enters through the back. Match sample color to a color standard. Record as ppm Total Residual Chlorine.



NOTE: Thoroughly clean and rinse test tubes after each use.
